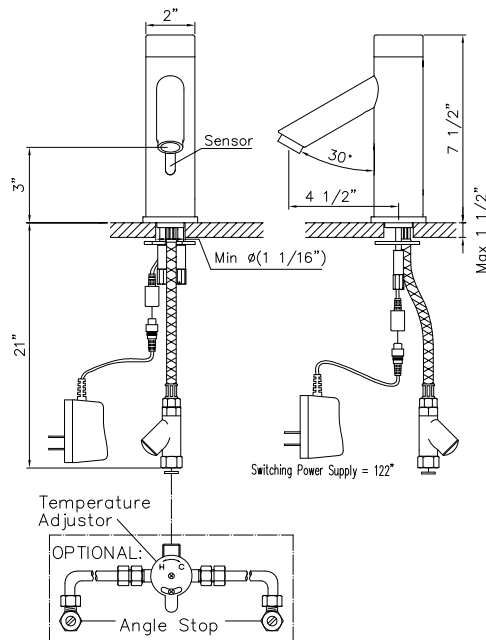

#### H-7000E (AC Powered)



#### Operation:

1. A continuous, invisible beam is emitted from the sensor.
2. The faucet is activated by placing hands under the spout within the effective range of the beam. Water starts to flow immediately for as long as the user's hands remain in the sensor range.
3. When hands are removed, the water flow stops. The sensor will automatically reset and be ready for the next user.

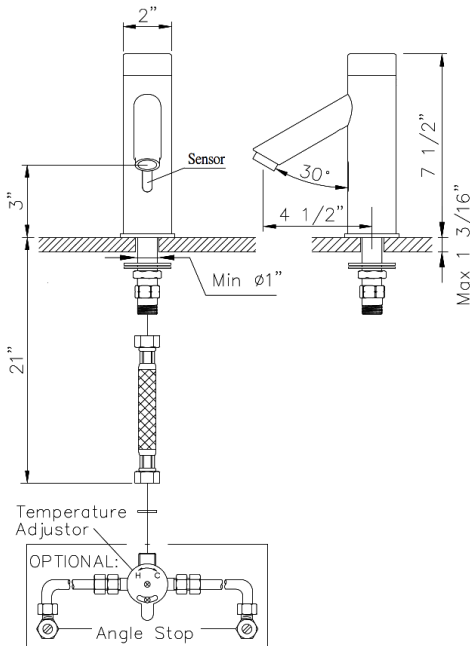

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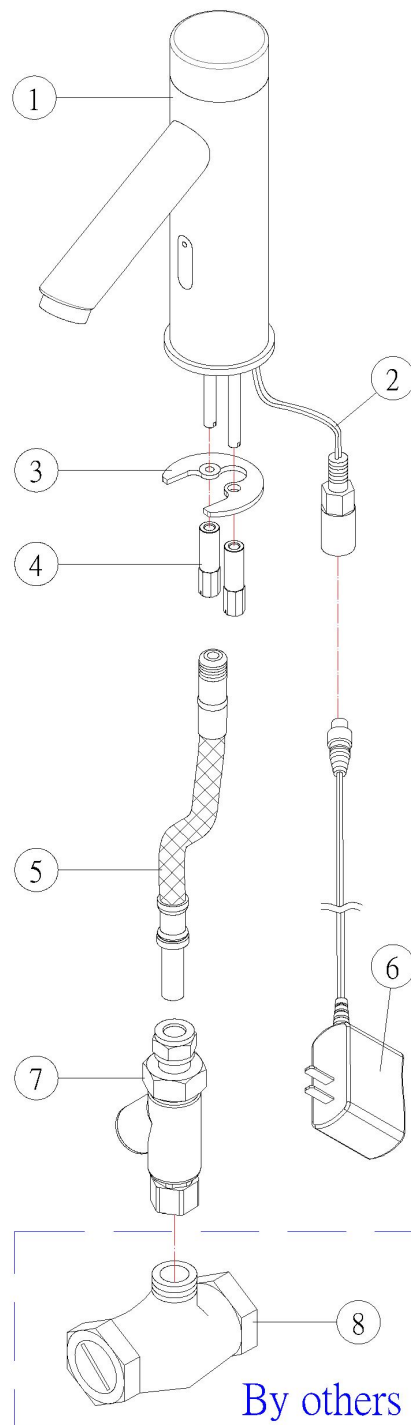

## Installation Instructions

### Installation Instructions:

1. Attach the plug-in adapter(6) to the AC connector(2) and plug the plug-in adapter into a powered outlet. Place hand in front of spout, it should click. If not, check the connection between the AC connector and plug-in adapter.
2. Connect the supply tube(5) to the faucet by turning the threaded ends into the bottom of the body(1). Teflon tape is **NOT REQUIRED**.  
**DO NOT USE PIPE DOPE.**
3. Remove the washer(3) and lock nuts(4) and slide the faucet supply rods through the deck hole. If there are 3 holes, use the cover plate(4"or 8") from Hydrotek, call 800-922-9883. Tighten faucet to deck using washer(3) and lock nuts(4).
4. Connect in-line filter(7) to the supply tube and the in-line filters to the stop valves(8). A 3/8" union connector (**provided by others**) is required to connect the inline filters to the stop valves.
5. Turn on water from the stop valve and check for leaks.
6. Place hand in front of the sensor eyes, water should start to flow. Remove hands, water stops.
7. **IMPORTANT:** The control stop valve should never be opened to the point where the flow from valve exceeds the flow capability of the sink fixture. In the event of a valve failure, the sink fixture must be able to accommodate a continuous flow from the valve.
8. **IMPORTANT:** This product contains mechanical components that are subject to normal wear. Periodical maintenance is required in order to maintain the faucet performance.
9. **DO NOT USE** abrasives, acids or cleaning fluids to clean Hydrotek Sensor faucet. Use only soap and water then wipe with clean cloth or towel.

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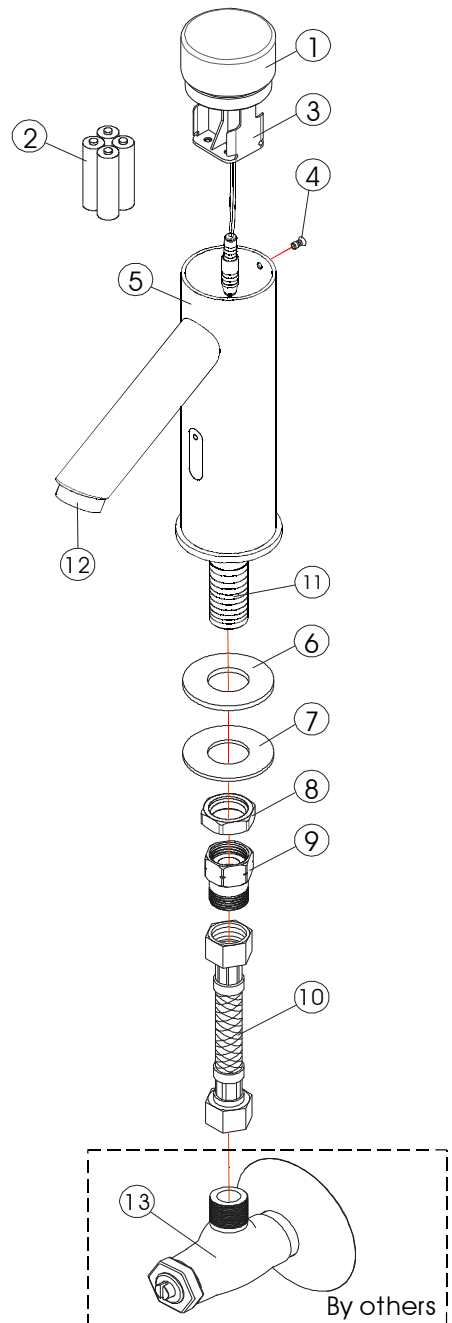

## Installation Instructions

### Installation Instructions:

1. Using the wrench supplied, remove the Set Screw(4) and carefully pull up on the Top Cap(1).
2. Insert Batteries(2) into the Battery Holder(3). Gently insert the battery holder assembly into the Top Cap(1). Slowly push wire connector and the top cap including the battery holder down into the Body(5). Be gentle in order to avoid crimping the wire.
3. Attach the Set Screw(4) on the back of the faucet. Place a hand in front of the spout, it should click. If not, check the battery contacts and wires.
4. Remove the Rubber Gasket(6), Washer(7), and Lock Nut(8) and slide the faucet Supply Rod(11) through the deck hole. Secure the faucet to the deck from the underside with the Rubber Gasket(6), Washer(7), and Lock Nut(8).
5. Install the Adapter with Filter(9) to the end of the Supply Rod(11). Connect the Supply Rod(11) and Stop Valve(13) using the Supply Tube(10).
6. Turn on the water from the Stop Valve(13) and check for leaks.
7. Place a hand in front of the sensor. Water should start to flow. Remove your hand and the water should stop.
8. **IMPORTANT:** The control stop valve should never be opened to the point where the flow from the valve exceeds the flow capability of the sink fixture. In the event of a valve failure, the sink fixture must be able to accommodate the continuous flow from the valve.
9. **IMPORTANT:** This products contains mechanical components that are subject to normal wear. Periodic maintenance is required in order to main faucet performance.
10. **NOTE:** Use only soap and water to clean the faucet. Abrasives, acids, or other cleaning fluids can damage the finish of the faucet.

## Sensor Operated Mixing Faucet

### Troubleshooting Guide

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Normal Operation: When power is connected, the faucet will immediately perform diagnostic function. You will hear a clicking sound and see lights flash. When the user's hands are placed under the spout, the light will flash once and water will start to flow. Water flow will stop when hands are removed. The red indicator light will flash when the batteries are low.

Turn the manual handle clockwise to increase temperature and counter-clockwise to decrease.

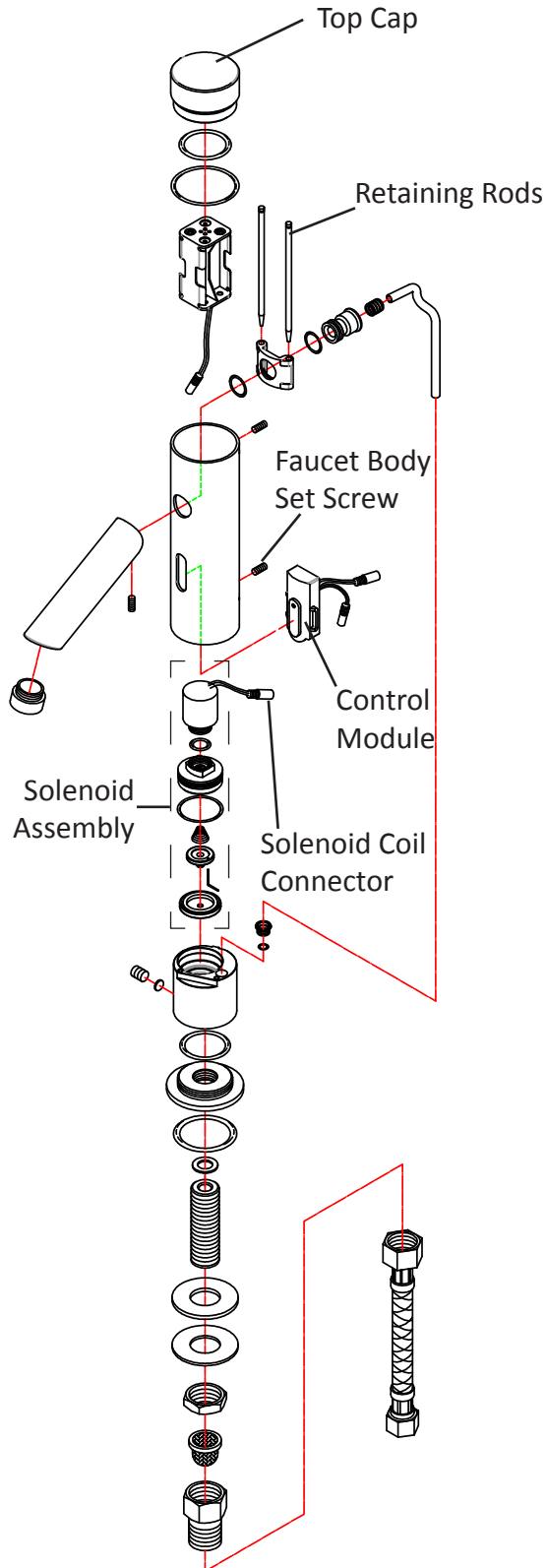

## Sensor Operated Mixing Faucet Maintenance Tasks



### PRESSURE RELEASE VALVE REPLACEMENT

1. Remove faucet **Top Cap**.
2. Remove batteries (battery powered faucets) or unplug power adapter (AC powered faucets).
3. Unscrew the **Faucet Body Set Screw** and with an upward motion, pull the the faucet body off of the faucet base.
4. Disconnect the **Solenoid Coil connector**.
5. Unscrew the **Solenoid Assembly** and remove it from the faucet base.
6. Install the new **Solenoid Assembly** and reassemble the faucet in reverse order.

### CONTROL MODULE (P.C. BOARD) REPLACEMENT

1. Remove faucet **Top Cap**.
2. Remove batteries (battery powered faucets) or unplug power adapter (AC powered faucets).
3. Unscrew the **Faucet Body Set Screw** and with an upward motion, pull the faucet body off of the faucet base.
4. Disconnect the **Solenoid Coil** connector.
5. Pull the **Retaining Rods** up and out through the top of the faucet body.
6. Remove the **Control Module**.
7. Install the new **Control Module** and reassemble the faucet in reverse order.

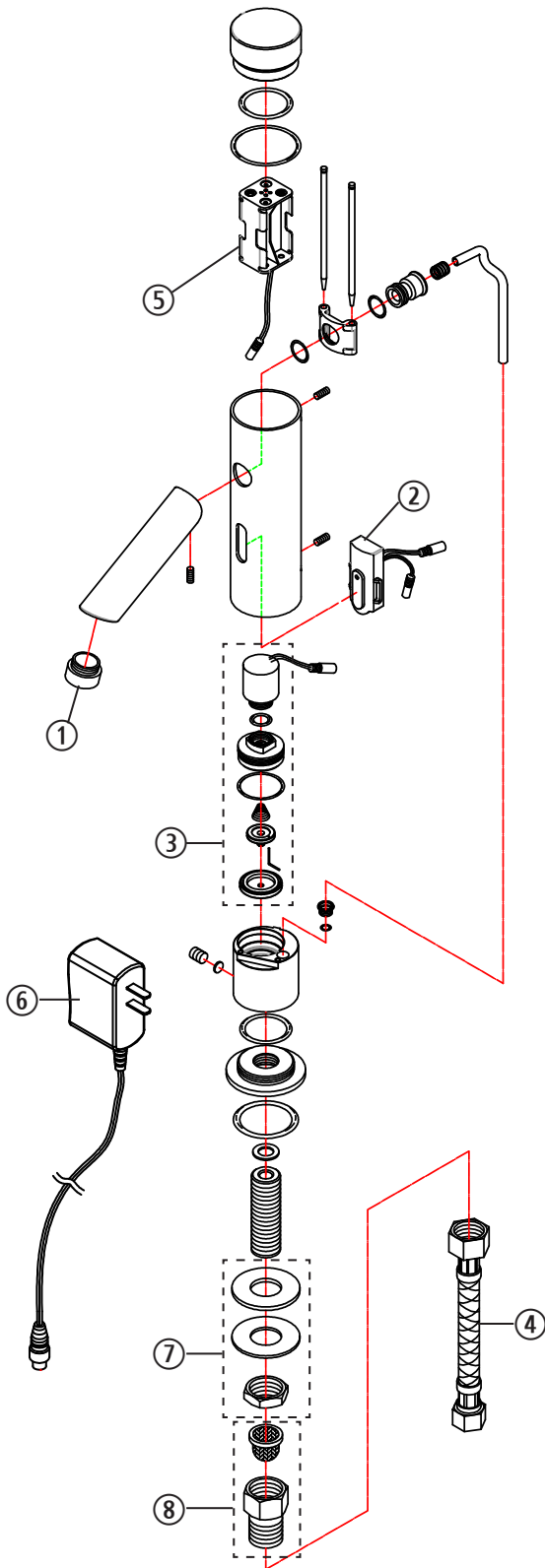
